Description of walk:	This is a highly popular trail with a mixture of lanes, forest tracks, quiet roads and open mountain. Walk commences on road in Southerly direction and remain on road until we pass signs for Stone Circle . We then commence our gentle climb on open ground to summit Cairn 284m Mount Corrin. We continue on following Sheep’s head way markings until we break off from Barnageehy loop.We proceed through forest tracks then break on to a country road which leads us back for 4 km to Durrus. Beautiful views of Dunmanus bay to the West with Nowen Hill and Knockboy to the East along the way.Can we quiet boggy and soft in places so Gaiters and poles recommended.
