Description of walk:	The Cailleach Beara Loop is immensely rewarding. What better way to really stretch the legs and enjoy unmatched views of the Kerry Cork borderlands and the natural beauty of the Sheen Valley. This loop takes us up Realagh Hill from the valley floor to the heights of ESK Mountain with a fine ridge walk to Turners Rock. On Laneways, woodland tracks across country and hills. There are fine views of the Valley and The Sheehy and Caha Mountains. There is a steep descent towards end of walk. WALKING BOOTS, GAITERS and POLES REQUIRED. GREAT CARE TO BE TAKEN ESPECIALLY ON THE STEEP DESCENT. Walkers can visit Molly Gallivan's a 200 year old cottage and family run visitor centre with craft shop, restaurant and tea rooms all set on a traditional farm after our hike.
