

Mahon Falls – Comeragh Moderate Walk

Desription of walk:	Leaving the carpark, we walk in towards the falls at Com Mahon along the gravel track. After taking a few minutes to admire the water cascading over the large rocks, we cross over to the right side of the falls and head up the steep incline to the top of the falls (80 m). We will then head south along the top of Keating's Cliff to Stáicin (spot height 668) admiring the Mahon Fall valley below,. We now turn North West and head over to the top of Com Tae (Spot height 707) where we can admire the com below us and spot the seven sisters. We will then head south and descend the ridge to the 300-metre level and back towards Ned Curran's old homestead. We'll pick-up the track back thru the forest and climb back up to the road and carpark This hike involves a bit of scramble on initial part as well as a cliff walk - the plateau on top is featureless moorland but the views to the South across country Waterford and out to the coast are well worth the effort of walking the ridge.
